The third edition of the Electrochimica colloquia "From the Volcano plot to the Electrocatalysis of small molecules" was intended for honoring such a great scientist and electrochemist. The meeting was hosted in the historical aula A "Raffaello Nasini" of the Chemical Science Department of Padova University. The event was supported by the International Society of Electrochemistry, The Electrochemistry Division of the Italian Chemical Society and by the Department of Chemical sciences. The event was promoted by the mailing list of the Italian Chemical Society, and on the socials: Twitter, LinkedIn and Facebook, which allowed to reach Scientists of foreign countries. - 6. Achille De Battisti (University of Ferrara) Sergio Trasatti, a Scientific and Human Profile. Memories of a Lifelong Friendship and Collaboration
